



Public declaration of Status Correction – The South African Assembly©

With all the current confusion regarding reconveyance to the Land and Soil Jurisdiction, The South African Assembly maintains this internationally recognised process:

The minimum requirement for reconveyance to the Land and Soil Jurisdiction is as such:

Step 1 – Voter deregistration

You need to deregister from the voters roll, as registration implies consent. If registered, you are unknowingly consenting to be controlled by a registered governmental corporation.

Step 2 – Complete your 528 document package (easy with our LRO document generator) **which includes:**

- Universal Declaration
- 2 x Witness Testimony Forms
- Recording cover letter

These will need to be **autographed** in blue ink with your seal in red ink. (<https://lro-sa.co.za>)

Step 3 – Department of Home Affairs

You now need to send a copy of these documents to **Home Affairs**.
(cover letter - 2 pages, 1 x Universal Declaration, 2 x Witness testimony pages)

These can either be sent via *registered post* or *registered email*, **as you will require proof that this was done.**

Step 4 – Upload your documents to the Land Recording Office. This puts your Status Correction on the Public Record

You will need the following documents to upload:

- Universal declaration
- 2 x Witness testimonies
- Selfie picture
- ID card/document as a .jpeg file.
- Proof of address:- This document must have your name and the same street address that you put on the Universal Declaration - save this document as a .pdf file.
- Thumb prints:- The picture you took of your right thumb prints on a white background - as a .jpeg file.

The LRO is there to keep a copy of your documents to prove that you are now firmly in the Land and Soil Jurisdiction!

Your LRO number can be searched as proof of your jurisdictional status correction.

If any of these steps have been missed, you need to correct them to fall within international standards for Land and Soil Jurisdiction Declaration.

Once the **new banking system** is open, these documents will be ready to upload. (Only for new accounts.)
